Follow-up Questions

1. Read Romans 3:1-4. Share about a time when you were disillusioned by the unfaithfulness of a Christian.
2. Have you ever found yourself looking at the lives of Christians around you instead of focusing on God's character?
3. Share about a time when you encountered a Christian who inspired and encouraged your faith. Would you say you're this sort of example to others? Why or why not?
4. The text this week dealt with human depravity. Broken people living in a broken world are bound to face sorrow and difficulty. Where do you feel brokenness most keenly in your personal life? (Is it in your marriage, parenting, work, dating relationships, habitual sin?) Pray for one another in these areas.
